Safely Cleaning Your Sterling & Seaglass Jewelry

Jewelry items are packaged in glass top aluminum tins. When you are not wearing your jewelry, store it in the tin... this will help slow tarnishing (which happens to all sterling silver jewelry) by keeping it airtight.

If your jewelry does tarnish, you can clean it by scrubbing it with a soft wire brass brush with warm water and liquid dish detergent.

When I have more than one piece of my seaglass jewelry to clean, I use the following recipe. It does not harm the sterling silver, the seaglass, or glass beads, but I do not know what happens to other metals or stones.

- Line a bowl with aluminum foil
- Spread out the seaglass jewelry on the foil
- Sprinkle about 1/2 cup of baking soda over the jewelry
- Sprinkle about 1/4 cup of salt over the jewelry
- Slowly pour boiling water over that until it stops fizzing
- Rinse your jewelry and dry it thoroughly before storing it
